

SRI 4-H Fair Goats



Goat Guidelines:

1. Ownership or Management Deadline: June 1st (animals over 6 months in age) and July 1st (kids 0-6 months)
2. Show Clothing: White or Khaki pants, white shirt, and brown or black belt
3. NO HORNED ANIMALS
4. Bucklings under 8 weeks old, at the time of the show, may be brought to the fairgrounds at the dams side for nursing purposes only, but cannot be shown. The exhibitor is responsible for making sure they are secured in their pen at all times. This may mean bringing a large crate or other means to ensure they will stay in the pen with mom. NO OTHER BUCKS ALLOWED and NO BOTTLE BUCKLINGS ALLOWED.
5. For registered breed classes: the original certificate of registration is required for all animals 6 months of age or older. A stamped copy is accepted for animals under 6 months of age.
6. There will also be a class for unrecorded (unregistered) animals.
7. All animals (registered or unregistered) must be identified by permanent identification (tattoo or permanent ear tag unique to that individual animal). All animals must be under the exhibitor's name, otherwise, management papers are needed. Farm-registered animals must be managed by 4-H members even if owned by a family member.
8. Breeds with more than 5 animals present will have their type class. All others will be put in all other breeds. Requirements for champion classes are at the discretion of the judge and superintendent.
9. The pet/wether class is only for those who do not have goats in another class.

Goat Classes:

1. Junior 0-4 months old
2. Junior 4-6 months old

3. Junior 6-12 months old
4. Junior 12-24 months old
5. Senior under 2 years old
6. Senior 2-3 years old
7. Senior 3-4 years old
8. Senior 4-5 years old
9. Senior 5+ years old
10. Dry Senior Doe
11. Pet/Wether Class - only for those exhibitors who do not have goats in other classes.
12. Fitting & Showmanship
 - Novice (never shown before)
 - Cloverbud (5-7)
 - Junior (8-10)
 - Intermediate (11-13)
 - Senior (14-18)
