

SRI 4-H Fair Beef Cattle



Beef Cattle Guidelines:

1. Ownership or Management Deadline: Steers by February 1st. All heifers before May 10th.
2. Any member may exhibit an animal of any recognized beef breed or crossbreed being raised either for meat or breeding purposes. Depending upon entries, there may be separate classes by breed for steers and for breeding stock.
3. Show Clothing: Blue Jeans and Blouses, Polo Shirts, Tee Shirts or Plaid Shirts. Must have a clean appearance without any patches.
4. Horns are only allowed for heifers of the following breeds: registered Horned Hereford, registered Scottish Highlander, and registered Texas Longhorns.
5. Bull calves under three (3) months of age, at the time of the show, will be allowed in showmanship or at the dam's side in the proper class for the dam. A feeder calf may be added at the discretion of the superintendent. NO OTHER BULLS ARE ALLOWED!

Beef Cattle Classes:

Steers will be weighed on the Friday night of the fair.

1. Bull Calf, under 3 months of age
2. Light Weight Steer
3. Medium Weight Steer
4. Heavy Weight Steer
5. Female 0-6 months
6. Female 6-12 months
7. Female 12-24 months
8. Cow over 24 months - must be shown with calf, under 6 months of age, at side
9. Fitting & Showmanship
 - Novice (never shown an animal)
 - Cloverbud (5-7)
 - Junior (8-10)
 - Intermediate (11-13)
 - Senior (14-18)
